I am writing to you to list my objection along with that of many of my constituents, to the planning application 16/06978/FUL, for the proposed residential development of 48 dwellings, with public open space, associated access, infrastructure and landscaping on the land south of Tewkesbury Way, Swindon, Wiltshire.

As you may be aware I try not to get involved in planning matters, however, the proposed scheme will have a disproportionately negative impact on my constituency. In addition, the land in question falls outside the line of development as outlined in Wiltshire's Local Plan and approved very recently by the Council & Planning Inspectorate.

This is an unwelcome proposal right on the doorstep of the historic Lydiard House and Country Park, is not in accordance with the Local Plan and should be resisted.
