### Finance

The Precept for year 2017/18 was discussed and it was agreed to keep the same figure as last year £7,500.

The Parish Council received a letter from Hook, Greatfield and Greenhill Village Hall committee requesting a grant towards improving the car park of the hall sometime during this coming year. This was discussed and it was agreed to make a financial contribution to the hall. The cost of the work would be between £9,000 and £10,000 pounds: it was decided to donate £2,000.
